ALBÚFERA DE MEDIO MUNDO ①

How to get there

Take the Panamericana Norte and then take the turn at Km 171.

LOMAS DE LACHAY ④

Lomas de Lachay is an ecological paradise where you will find camping sites and hiking roots.

How to get there

Take the Panamericana Norte and then take the turn at Km 101.

SAN JERÓNIMO ⑦

San Jerónimo is the perfect place to hike, camp by water falls and enjoy nature.

HUANCAYA ⑩

Perhaps Huancaya is one of the best places to go camping in Lima.

How to get there

Take the road from Lunahuaná to Huancaya, you'll drive by Viñac and Yauyos on the way.

LUNAHUANÁ ⑬

Peace and quiet, relax, prawns, wine, nature and beauty. This is the place to lay back and have a wonderful weekend.

Where to lodge

CHURÍN ②

Chill out in Churín, 6 hrs. drive from Lima, make sure you go on a 4x4 because it can get pretty bumpy and very dusty. The location is famous for its thermal waters.

How to get there

Go to Huacho and take the turning root at Km 207 of the Panamericana Norte. The road is paved until Sayán, beyond this point you get a gravel/dirt track.

CHANCAY ⑤

Here you will encounter the eco-truly Hare Krishna community where you can practice peaceful meditation and yoga.

How to get there

Take the Panamericana Norte and then take the turn at Km 63.

CIENEGUILLA ⑧

It's a concurred winter meeting place in the Lurín river valley. It's a nice place to take the family for a picnic.

Lodging

YAUYOS ⑪

Yauyos is a beautiful natural reserve to enjoy on a 4x4, located at the south/east portion of the Lima outback

CERRO AZUL ⑭

This is a fully functional marine resort with all services where people go at the end summer.

How to get there

Take the Panamericana Sur and stop at Km 131.

HUANCAHUASI ③

The thermal location of Huancachuasi is 20Kms from Churín, about one hr. drive. Where to lodge Both Hostal churín and Hostal Acuario, offer accommodation, be sure to take your bathing suits and don't forget the warm clothing to overcome nocturnal chills.

CANTA ⑥

This is the classic place to spend Easter holidays, Obrajillo, the Cantamarca archeological site and the Cordillera de la Viuda, are some of its attractive tourist sites.

How to get there

Take the Túpak Amaru Av. to exit Lima, follow through the Canta/La Viuda road which happens to be in good conditions. You will find bus stations in front of the entrenches 4 and 5 of the UNI.

AZPITIA ⑨

The valley offers a stretch of lush green by the Río Mala where the gastronomical specialties are apple pisco and tasty prawn dishes.

Where to lodge

Hotel el Mayoral de Azpitia, tel: 530-3022. Locals also give lodging at fair prices.

It's the perfect place for adventure tourism, horse riding, mountain-bike and trekking.
